Wordy (87 words)

B. Weak Verbs

Wordy

The earth's axis <u>has</u> a tilt as the planet <u>is</u> in orbit around the sun so that the northern and southern hemispheres <u>are</u> alternately in alignment toward the sun.

Concise

The earth's axis <u>tilts</u> as the planet <u>orbits</u> the sun so that the northern and southern hemispheres alternately <u>align</u> toward the sun.

C. Passive Voice

Wordy

During its winter the northern hemisphere is tilted farthest away from the sun so that the nights are made longer and the days are made shorter.

Concise

During its winter the northern hemisphere <u>tilts</u> away from the sun, <u>making</u> the nights longer and the days shorter.

Better

During its winter the northern hemisphere tilts away from the sun, lengthening the nights and shortening the days.

Concise

<u>Delays and cost overruns</u> plagued construction of the Channel Tunnel. <u>Investors expect</u> to earn profits at last, now that <u>trains pass</u> daily through the tunnel.

V. Combining Sentences

Wordy

An unexpected problem with the Channel Tunnel is stowaways. The stowaways are mostly illegal immigrants. They are trying to smuggle themselves into England. They cling to train roofs and undercarriages.

Concise
